News/Issues:

- I am planning to stop offering drop-in hours for the information & referral services on Thursday evenings. Instead, I will make myself available in the evenings if someone makes an appointment. I feel that being at the library for two extra hours on a Thursday evening, when so few people have dropped in during that time, is not a good use of my time.
